

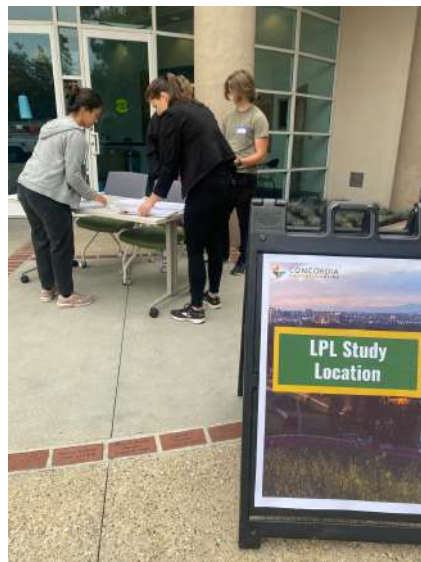


CUI Summer Research Institute Newsletter
